Contest Details, Guidelines and Requirements:

Students must be in grades 9-12 to enter.

Students are invited to create a poster about organ and tissue donation awareness.

Artwork must be original. No copyrighted or trademarked artwork will be accepted for judging with the exception of the Donate Life logo.

Entries must include positive and accurate messaging about organ and tissue donation, and include the phrase “**organ and tissue donation**”. Entries are also encouraged to include the national online Donor Register website: “**RegisterMe.org**”.

Posters must be at least 8.5x11” and no larger than 18x24”.

Please leave a 1” border around your poster, no writing, image or drawing within 1” of the edges.

Entries must not have grammatical or spelling errors.

Entries must have a completed entry form attached to your poster (must be legible, see below for mailing address).

E-mail graphic design entries only to VolunteerServices@nedso.org and include the entry form information.

Please do not fold or frame your poster.

Students may enter one poster and posters must be received by March 10, 2023.

Winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on criteria of originality, artistic merit and effective use of theme.

Posters that do not follow these guidelines will be disqualified.
