### **Is there a training course I need to attend?**

After you fill out your volunteer application you will be contacted by our Volunteer Program Manager to schedule your orientation. Orientations are held on zoom or in person at our office located in Waltham, MA.

### **Is there a minimum number of volunteer hours or activities required?**

There are no mandatory time requirements, we appreciate anytime you are available!

### **Is there a dress code?**

Volunteers are encouraged to wear Donate Life apparel (provided by NEDS) appropriate for the event/activity and we also encourage dressing in the Donate Life colors supporting donation, **blue** and **green**!

Volunteers are encouraged to wear their volunteer lanyard and badge to events.

### **Does NEDS provide reimbursement?**

NEDS reimburses volunteers for parking expenses at volunteer events and activities, send a picture of your parking receipt to our Volunteer Program Manager.

### **Does NEDS participate in fundraising?**

NEDS hosts annual walks in the spring and fall; we have a race team for the Falmouth Road Race on Cape Cod; and we host a golf tournament. Volunteers can also host their own fundraisers, as an event or FB fundraiser. We do not fundraise at our informational/donor registry tables, fundraisers are set up as separate activity, contact us for ideas.

### **Can I reach out in my community to host an activity?**

Absolutely! Volunteers are encouraged to seek out opportunities in your community, at your workplace, school or a group you may belong to. Resources are available for your activities.
