




2022 Key Statistics



36% Growth in Total Organ Donors since 2020




Donation after Brain Death (DBD)

Donors who are declared dead based on neurologic criteria which is defined by the irreversible loss of all functions of the brain, including the brain stem.

Donation after Circulatory Death (DCD)

Donors who are declared dead based on circulatory criteria which is defined as irreversible cessation of circulatory respiratory functions.

NEDS works to create a world where everyone has opportunities to succeed and to live healthy lives. Again last year NEDS promoted equity both in the work it does and in the communities it serves.

NEDS sponsored it's second annual Equity in Transplantation National Symposium, Effective Initiatives to Reduce Transplant Disparities. Distinguished nationally-recognized speakers presented on best practices transplant center and transplant-affiliated health care organizations use to assure fairer access to transplantation.

A key organizational goal is for staff to directly engage with communities served by NEDS through volunteer organizations and events that benefit underserved population in the region. Last year staff participated in the Hartford, Connecticut Toy Giveaway, provided essential hygiene products to Greater Boston school-aged children in need through Hope & Comfort, a Needham, MA-based nonprofit and a bike building day where staff built, tested and decorated bikes for appreciative members of the Watertown, MA Boys & Girls Club.
