

New England Donor Services High School Poster Contest Rules:

- Students are invited to create a poster in support of organ and tissue donation.
- The teacher with the most student submissions (one per student) can also win a **\$50 Amazon gift card** for classroom materials.
- The contest is open to students in grades 9-12.
- Artwork must be original. No copyrighted artwork will be accepted with the exception of the Donate Life logos, Done Vida logo and New England Donor Services logo.
- Entries must include positive and accurate information and include wording: “organ donation”.
- Entries are also encouraged to include the national donor registry: “RegisterMe.org”.
- Find organ and tissue donation facts at <https://donatelife.net/> and scan QR code below to watch a 2 minute video about organ donation.
- Posters must be at least 8.5x11” and no larger than 18x24”.
- Entries must not have grammatical or spelling errors.
- Posters must have a completed **entry form** attached to your poster (see following page).
- E-mail graphic design entries only to VolunteerServices@neds.org and include the entry form information on the following page. You will receive an email confirmation.
- Do not fold or frame your poster.
- Winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on criteria of originality, artistic merit and effective use of theme.
- All entries become the property of New England Donor Services and originals will not be returned. Posters may be displayed at state/government offices, hospitals, and other public locations in the New England region.
- **Entries must be received by March 13, 2026 to be included in the contest.**
